Thank you to everyone that participated in making the 2017 Butterflies In My Garden that I designed. Here are the finishing instructions for the 28-1/2" x 34" final sized piece:

1/3 yd. black wool
7/8 yd. backing fabric of choice – I used a yarn dyed flannel

Assemble the center of the piece using the layout I have provided.

Cut 4 strips of wool – 2" x wof; subcut two lengths 31" long (this is a little longer than needed, but since the wool tends to stretch, add the two side borders, then trim to size.

Cut two more lengths 2" x 30" – add to the top and bottom, trim to size.

Add your backing fabric, stitch with a blanket stitch around the entire piece using Valdani perle cotton size 8.

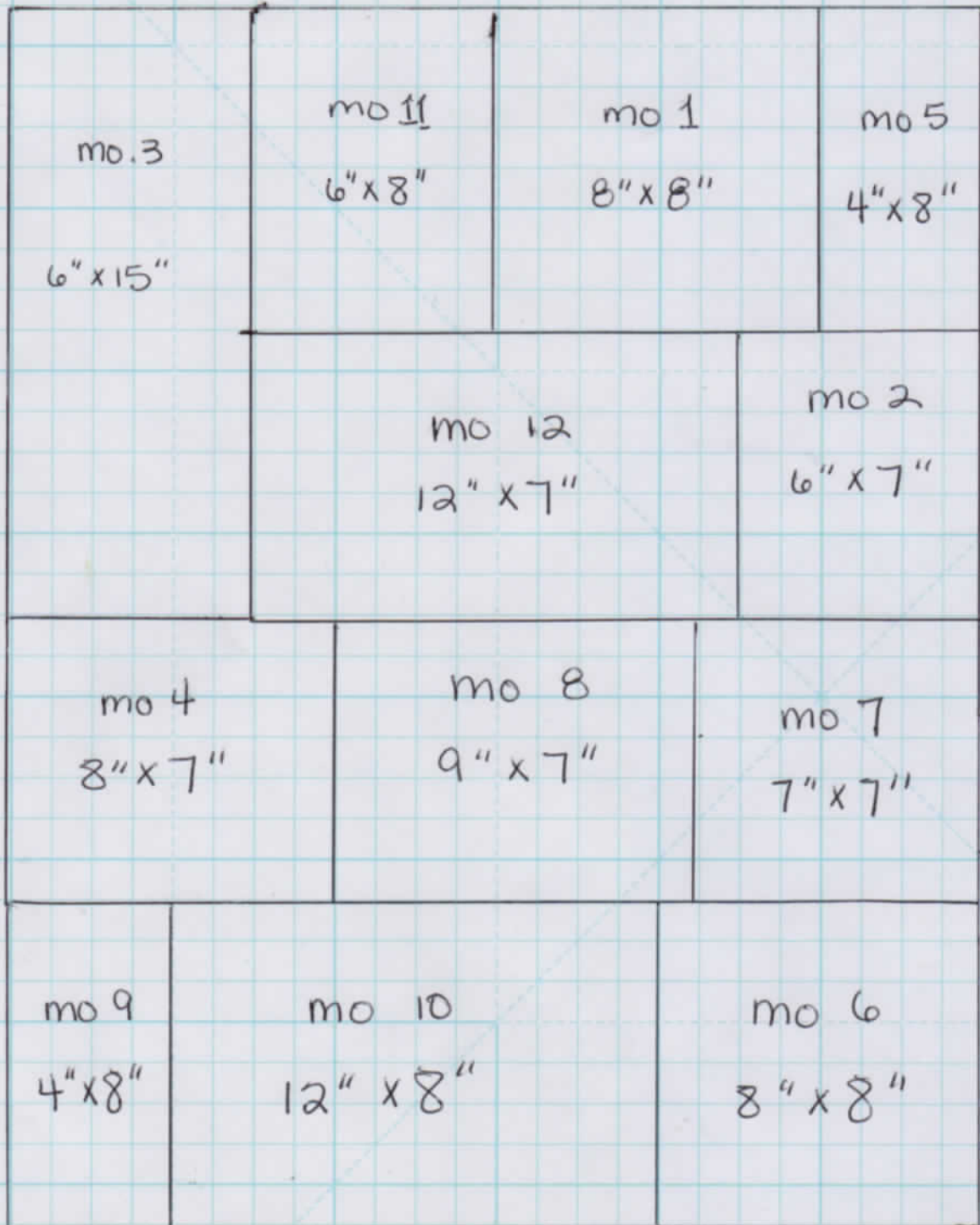
Cut 1 strip – 1-1/2" x wof (tabs if you want them); subcut into four 8" long pieces. I stitched down each side of the tabs with a blanket stitch, using Valdani perle cotton size 8. Fold the tabs in half (4" opening), stitch to the back of the quilt. If you choose not to add hanging sleeves, you can get away with 1/4 yard of wool.
